Issue number 1—2 2015 consists of several literary and humanities texts, as well as reviews.

The core of the issue is a translation into Belarusian of the famous “The Da Vinci Code” by the American writer **Dan Brown**.

A historian and writer from Hrodna **Sciapan Sturejka** has published in the issue his text “Forward! Return.”, which is based, to a great degree, on the real history of his family.

A lecturer of the Maksim Tank Belarusian State Pedagogical University **Viktar Konliech** in his article „Belarusian and Russian Bilingualism: Myth or Reality” considers the peculiarity of the contemporary language situation in Belarus. His research is based on the results of a poll conducted among the students of the university mentioned.

The issue finishes with two reviews, namely those by a journalist and essay-writer from Vilnia **Andranik Antanian** “Striking Symptomatology” and a doctoral student of Biblical theology, a Catholic priest **Siarhiej Surynovič** “Precious Achievements of Belarusian Biblical Studies”.
